Linkinhorne Parish Council hereby applies to Cornwall Council to designate the parish area of Linkinhorne as a Neighbourhood Area, in accordance with part 2(5)(1) of the Neighbourhood Planning Regulations 2012. Please see map attached.

The area for the Neighbourhood Plan will be the parish of Linkinhorne, altogether a population of approximately 1300.

Linkinhorne Parish Council serves the whole parish of Linkinhorne and is well placed to oversee the Neighbourhood Planning process.

A map identifying the area, that is the parish of Linkinhorne, to which the application relates forms part of this application.

This area is considered appropriate to be designated as a neighbourhood area for the following reasons:

- The area forms the parish of Linkinhorne
- The area already has legal and administrative status
- The Linkinhorne Parish Plan 2003 (updated)

Linkinhorne Parish is the relevant body for the purposes of section 61G of the 1990 Town and Country Planning Act being the parish council for the entire area applying for designation.
