Application under Part 2 (5) (1) of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 for the designation of a Neighbourhood Area.

Morval Parish Council gives notice that it wishes to make an application under Part 2 (5) (1) of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 for the designation of a neighbourhood area for the Morval Parish Neighbourhood Development Plan.


Morval Parish abuts the Parish of St Martin by Looe at No mans land and at this Boundary are 11 properties in Springfield Park. It is known that these residents identify with St Martins Parish as they are close to the Village Hall. For this reason it seemed appropriate that these residents be canvassed as to whether they wished to remain in the Morval Parish Neighbourhood Plan or align with St Martins by Looe Neighbourhood Plan if this council was to embark on a plan of its own. A letter was hand delivered to all of these residents explaining the plan and their options with a cut-off date of the 6th July 2014 for their views to be made known. The letter stated that if no response was received by this date it was assumed that they were happy to remain within the Morval Parish Neighbourhood Plan Area.

No negative responses were received so there is no requirement to amend the boundary.

This area is considered appropriate to be designated as a Neighbourhood Area for the following reasons.

- 1. The designated Neighbourhood Plan Area is formed by the existing Morval Parish Council boundary and is currently represented and served by 10 Parish Councillors.
- 2. The proposed area already has legal and administrative status.
- 3. Morval Parish Council is the relevant body for the purposes of section 61G of the 1990 Town and Country Planning Act being the Parish Council for the entire area applied for.
