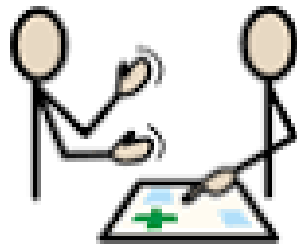
Observing and responding to patterns of communication that may not be noticed

"Foundations of communication"

- **Sharing personal space**
- **Developing the ability to attend to that person**
- **Concentration and attention span**
- **Learning to do sequences of activity with another person**
- **Taking turns in exchanges of behaviours**
- **Using and understanding eye contact, facial expressions and physical contacts**
- **Using and understanding non-verbal body language and gesture**
- **Vocalisation has meaning**
- **Learning to regulate and control arousal levels**
- **Enjoying being with another person**
