What is Studio 61?

Studio 61 is a home for art-based activities including

- painting,
- printmaking,
- photography,
- cards,
- jewellery.

There are also ongoing communication sessions including 'sing and sign' and support for self-advocacy.

Regular activities

Throughout the year we hold exhibitions, both of work produced in the workshop, and by external artists, both with and without learning disabilities.

Recent exhibitions have included work by Sheila Kestle (see an example opposite), a joint show with Wadebridge School A level students and the Drym Valley Art Group.

Opening times

Studio 61 is open for trading, selling items produced on-site, as well as other art-work.
