Supportive Lifestyles will provide strength based &amp; personalised approach, working towards independence, outcomes and enablement.</li> <li>2. This support can be anything from a few hours a day to wrap around 24 hour support</li> <li>3. Housing options will include individual accommodation units within a scheme, existing shared housing, shared ownership or support in the person's own home</li> <li>4. Support will enable &amp; maximise individuals strengths, confidence &amp; work towards agreed health &amp; social care outcomes</li> <li>5. Augment meaningful community opportunities/supported employment</li> <li>6. Support will be creative &amp; consider equipment &amp; assistive technology which may promote independence</li> </ol>
<p><b>Individual hours for specific outcomes (1:1)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Individual Service Funds (ISF)/Individual Personal Commissioning (IPC)</li> </ul>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Approved Providers to manage ISF/IPC, co-design, broker &amp; support the individual to manage their personal budget to meet identified needs or through a managed account</li> <li>2. Person-centred support offering choice &amp; control &amp; flexibility of support</li> <li>3. Joining up health, social care &amp; other services to enable individuals to blend &amp; control resources available to them across the system in order to 'commission'</li> <li>4. Enable individuals to develop skills &amp; confidence to self-manage &amp; develop partnerships with peers &amp; community sector</li> </ol>
