Request and response:

1. No of children who have applied or in receipt of free school meals

As of 7th May 2019, 10,065 children were registered with Cornwall Council as eligible for Free School Meals.

2. No of children on pupil premium

The Department for Education data feed for the 2018/19 financial year indicated a total of 15,231 children in primary and secondary schools in Cornwall eligible for the 'EVER6' element of Pupil Premium. This includes children who have been eligible for Free School Meals at any point in the last six years.
