

Supplementary Statement to the Cornwall and Isles of Scilly Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment

The Regulations stipulate that Supplementary Statements can provide updates to the Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment (PNA) only in relation to changes in the availability of pharmaceutical services. Supplementary Statements cannot provide updates on pharmaceutical need: this can only be achieved through a review of the PNA.

The following items currently contained within the PNA (available at <http://www.cornwall.gov.uk/pharmacy>) have been identified as needing updating. This updated information supersedes some of the original information within the PNA and should be read in conjunction with that document.

The Cornwall and Isles of Scilly PNA published in April 2018 identified the need to keep under review the development at Nansleden in Newquay in order to assess its impact on provision locally. In order to meet this commitment the Newquay PNA profile summary has been updated giving the latest position for Newquay. Specific changes to pharmacy provision in the areas since the publication of the PNA include:
