The maximum home-school distance of children the tie-breaker distance criteria was applied to (i.e. excluding those given an admissions place because they were looked after, a sibling, teacher's child etc) in the admitted to Reception group (i.e. starting primary school) at Bosvigo and St Mary's Primary Schools in Truro for each of the intakes in 2019; 2018; 2017; 2016; 2015.
