The Regulations stipulate that Supplementary Statements can provide updates to the Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment (PNA) only in relation to changes in the availability of pharmaceutical services. Supplementary Statements cannot provide updates on pharmaceutical need: this can only be achieved through a review of the PNA.

The following items currently contained within the PNA (available at <http://www.cornwall.gov.uk/pharmacy>) have been identified as needing updating. This updated information supersedes some of the original information within the PNA and should be read in conjunction with that document.

Specific changes to pharmacy provision in the areas since the publication of the PNA include:

It is the view of the Cornwall and Isles of Scilly PNA Steering Group that these changes to the availability of pharmaceutical services are relevant to the granting of applications referred to in the NHS Act 2006 and that a revised Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment would be a disproportionate response.
