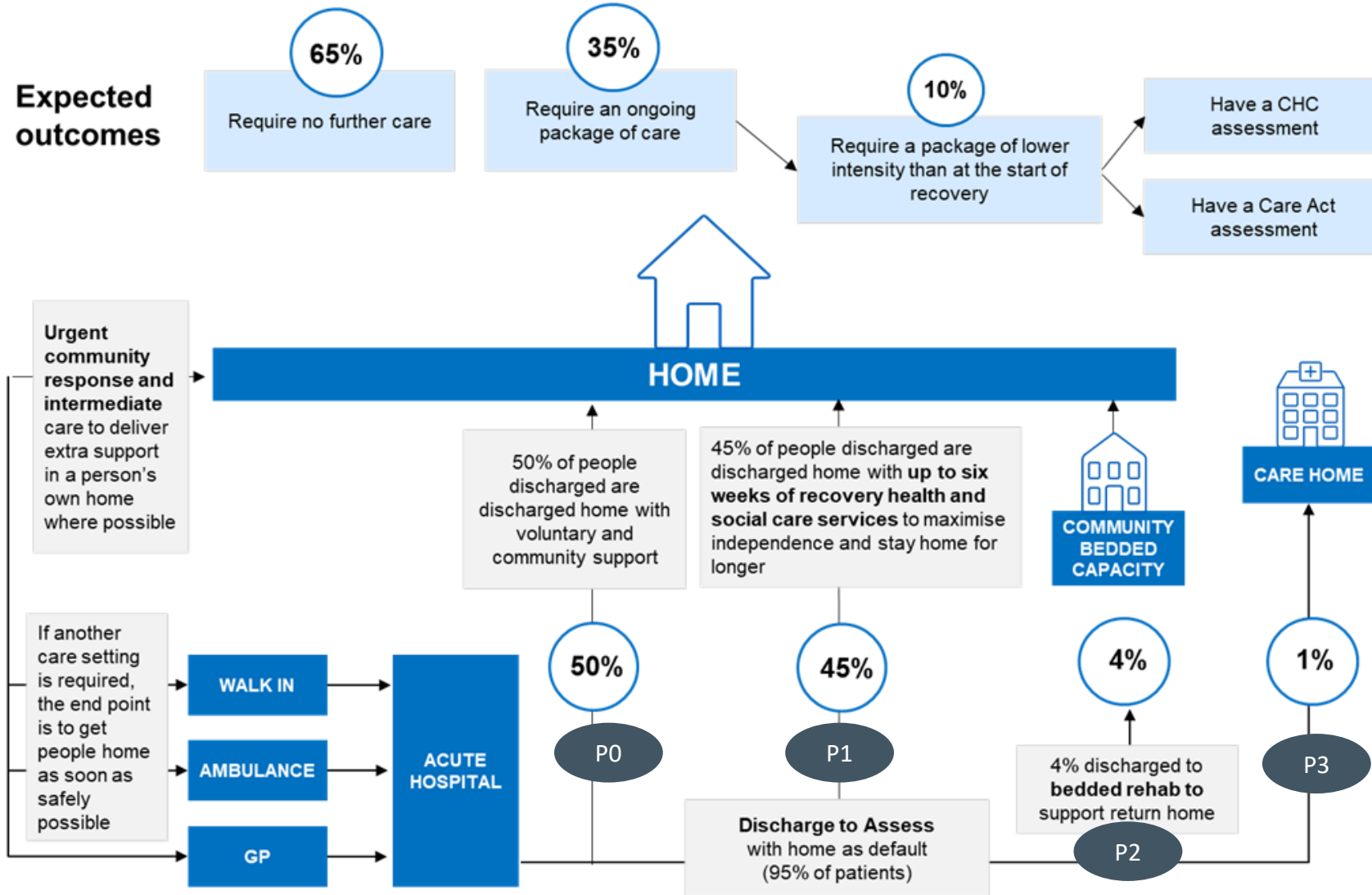
Market Update

- Currently have **450** unplaced domiciliary care requirements across Cornwall
 - 5000 plus hours per week, **£5m annual value**
 - Double handed packages, night support
 - Postcodes with 20+ requirements: TR14, PL13, and others
- **50** people waiting for a Care Home package but with specialist requirements;
20 identified vacancies;
Embrace Diagnostic indicated only 56% of placements into long term residential care ideal?
- **136** people are waiting in a hospital for a care home placement or package of care
- **System required to implement a Discharge to Assess Model**
Where possible a person will be discharged from hospital with a short term care package (up to 6 weeks) before a long term assessment is undertaken and a long term care package is sought

Discharge to Assess in Cornwall

Aim: to support people to maximise their independence and remain in their own home



- Central Government guidance issued in the summer requiring health and care systems to introduce Discharge to Assess approach
- In Cornwall STEPS, Home First and Corcare capacity being used to provide short term home based support (up to 6 weeks)
- Bank of temporary bedded care home beds and community hospitals
